The competition base documents are formed of this competition notice and the competition documents (**CD**) together with annexes. The object of the competition is the conclusion of a contract for the **wind farm service operation vessel technical documentation** in accordance with the conditions and specifications set out in CD and its annexes.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPETITION FOR A WINDFARM COMMISSIONING SERVICE OPERATION VESSEL (CSOV) TECHNICAL DOCUMENTATION

Technical documentation in English language of the design necessary for planning the construction of the CSOV must be prepared as a result of the conclusion of the agreement, based on which it would be possible to place a newbuilding order of CSOV(s).

CSOV that will be used for performing commissioning and maintenance works at offshore wind farms. CSOV will be working in demanding conditions, using advanced dynamic positioning and a high operational window for maximum uptime offshore. CSOV needs significant accommodation space for increased ship crew and motion-compensated walk-to-work gangway. Carbon emissions and efficiency optimisation are necessary.

If the Buyer has doubts about the authenticity, truthfulness, or reliability of the submitted documents or data, the Buyer has the right to request additional explanations, documents, or attaching an *Apostille* to the submitted documents.

THE COURSE OF THE COMPETITION AND OTHER CONDITIONS

The more detailed course and conditions of the competition are regulated in CD and its annexes. The competition is subject to the provisions of private law of the Republic of Estonia (§ 1009 - 1013 of the Law of Obligations Act), and this competition is not a public procurement within the meaning of the Public Procurement Act of the Republic of Estonia or

the European Union Public Procurement Directives. Pursuant to § 1012 (2) of the Law of Obligations Act, a decision made on the competition is binding and cannot be challenged in court.

The tender complying with CD and its annexes must have reached the Buyer by e-mail no later than November 8, 2023 at 16:00 (deadline for submission of tenders), time according to Eastern European time zone (GMT +2). Tenders submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

After the deadline for submission of tenders, the successful tender will be determined in three stages:

- compliance check of Tenderers and stage I tenders and evaluation of stage I tenders (stage I);
- negotiating with the Tenderers who passed stage I and submission of final tenders (stage II);
- evaluation of final tenders and announcement of the Tenderer who has submitted a successful tender (stage III).
